

CYPRUS JOINED THE EUROPEAN UNION IN 2004 AND HAS DEVELOPED INTO AN IMPORTANT FINANCIAL HUB, ESPECIALLY FOR INVESTORS.



The Cyprus Citizenship programme provides Cyprus citizenship to the investor, their married spouse and dependent children up to the age 28, provided they are in full-time education.

An investment of €2,000,000 can provide Cypriot passports, therefore EU citizenship, in just **6 months** and there is no requirement of residence in Cyprus.

Cypriot Citizenship via Investment is easy and straightforward. It is the fastest citizenship route within EU states.

The key requirements are:

- Be aged 18 or over
- Have no criminal record
- Invest €2,000,000 in stocks or government bonds for at least three years and buy a residential property with a purchase price of at least €500,000 exclusive of VAT;
or
- Invest €2,000,000 exclusive of VAT in property for at least three years

In all cases except investments in real estates, you must also possess a permanent privately

owned residence in Cyprus, the purchase price of which must be at least €500,000, plus VAT.

Benefits:

- Cyprus is an EU country; therefore, becoming a Cypriot citizen means becoming an EU citizen, which allows freedom of travel to and living in all EU countries
- Chance to become an EU citizen in just four months or less
- Visa-free travel to more than 140 countries, including Canada and Australia
- You, your spouse and your dependents can live, work and attend schools/universities in Cyprus or in any other EU country
- No extra tax on your income in either your home country or any other country
- No maximum age limit
- No maximum or minimum residency requirement
